### Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape provided.)
- Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
- Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
- Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.

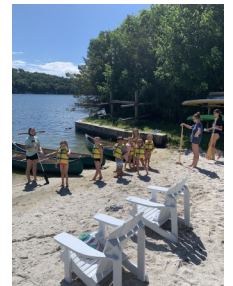

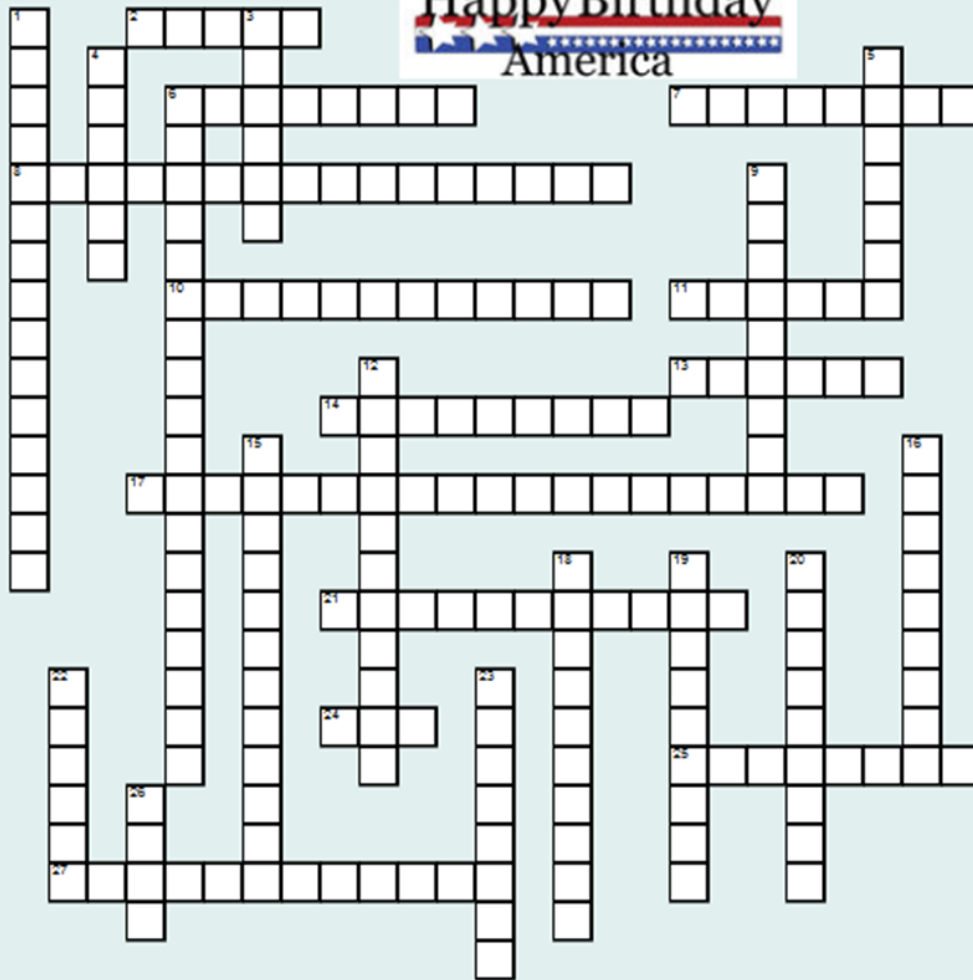
## CANDLEWOOD KNOLLS Established 1929 CHILDREN'S PROGRAM

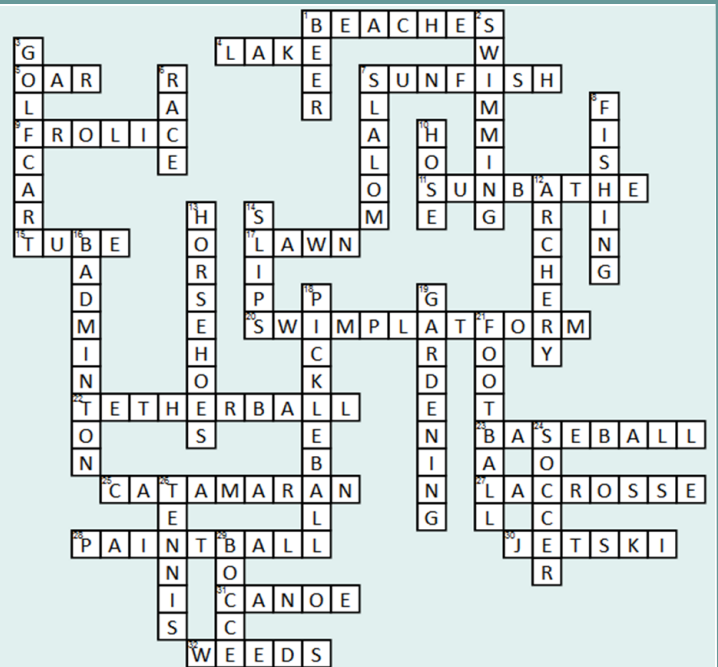

## RUN FOR THE KNOLLS!

PICK YOUR TEAM - SELECT YOUR HORSE - BUY YOUR SLOT

THEN IT'S OFF TO THE RACES!

Here's how it works:

- Form your teams – you can be on one team – or multiple teams – no limit on team size.
- Each team selects one team member to be their “horse” – and then dresses that individual in your team colors or costume. Make sure to name your “horse”!
- The registration fee for each “horse” is \$100.00.]
- There are 30 “horse” slots available.
- “Horses” must be registered and the registration fee paid by July 17th. “Horses” are registered by emailing your intent to: [knollsummer2020@gmail.com](mailto:knollsummer2020@gmail.com). Please include your name, email address, phone number and the name of your “horse”
- There are only 30 slots and they will be allocated on a first come first serve basis. Registration Fees can be dropped off at the Knolls office NO LATER THAN July 17<sup>th</sup>.
- There will be as many as six (6) heats of 6 “horses” each – five (5) of which are available for “horses” that you can buy. The last heat is reserved for the Children’s Program Counselor “horses”. The winner of each of the heats wins half of the pot and continues on to the Final Race. The winner of the Counselors’ heat moves to the Final Race as well. The winner of the Final Race wins a grand prize based on the number of participants ... or if the Counselor wins, the winnings are donated to Candlewood Knolls Children’s Program.
- “Horses” move down the track based upon the roll of 3 large dice. The presenting number identifies the “horse(s)” that may move down the track – one space each time their number comes up. *Think a board game where the pieces move based upon the roll of the dice.* Whatever “horse” crosses the finish line first ... wins!
- No special athletic skill is necessary! Anyone can be a team “horse”!

After the Final Race ... and we crown the winner ... the music begins!
