as hamburgers, hot dogs and all the fixings. All for a mere \$6 (\$3 for 12 and under, 3 and under are free).

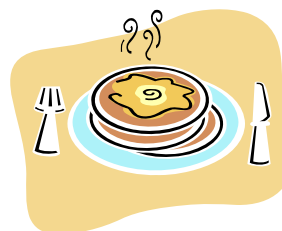
Oh, there is a bocce tournament as well. Don't know how to play? Don't worry, it's easy and we don't take it too seriously.

The menu includes:

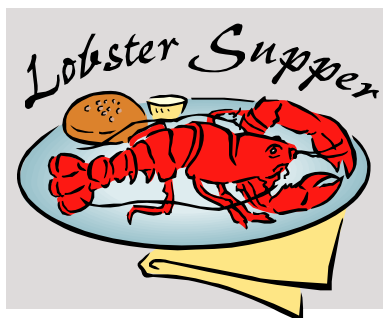
Lobster Dinner with garden salad, dinner rolls, baked potato and corn on the cob
