**Use Common Sense Safety Guidelines.**

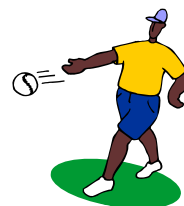
- Unlocked cars and golf carts easily accessible in driveways are easy targets for vandalism and theft.

## Photo Request

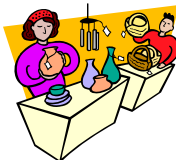
