



Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape provided.)
- Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
- Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
- Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.

The **Town of Bethel** was formed in 1855 and has a population of over 20,000 in 17 square miles. It is in northern Fairfield County and has small-town charm, an active community calendar of events, and a walkable downtown offering a variety of restaurants, coffee shops and parks. Bethel is also known as the birthplace of celebrated showman and entrepreneur Phineas Taylor Barnum. Here are some of the popular sites to visit:

Blue Jay Orchards: 125 Plumtree Road

A classic New England farm that is a 140-acre apple orchard and market. You can pick your own apples and enjoy a hayride to the pumpkin patch. The market has lots of local goodies. **Monster Mini Golf**: 13 Stony Hill Road

A state-of-the art indoor facility that has an 18-hole minature golf course and adventure, hi-tech video game arcade and monstrous prize center, mini bowling, monster themed laser tag, laser maze, light concessions, and more! Known for its memorable family entertainment, it is also host to many private birthday parties and events with themed private event rooms and customized event planning.

Staib Tree Farm: 49 Walnut Hill Road

A local option during the holidays where you can choose and cut your own Christmas tree! **Noteworthy Chocolates**: 213 Greenwood Avenue

A custom chocolate engraving service with chocolate gifts made in a peanut, tree nut, egg, wheat, shellfish, and fish FREE facility. You can order online or stop in for a mini tour (by appointment only)

Molten Java: 282 Greenwood Avenue

A community centered coffee house, café, art gallery and music venue allowing artists and musicians to share their talents.

Sycamore Drive-In Restaurant: 282 Greenwood Avenue

This is a Bethel Landmark that has been in continuous operation since 1948 with a menu that has been handed down from the original owners. They are known for their famous French Style Steak Burgers and Homemade Root Beer.

Broken Symmetry Gastro Brewery: 5 Depot Place

Open Wednesdays through Sundays offering lunch, dinner, brunch, specializing in Californiainspired cuisine and brewing a wide range of beers for customers to enjoy. They have many events including oktoberfest, trivia nights, live band karoake, farm to fork harvest dinners and much more!

BOOK REVIEW - The Nature of Fragile Things by Susan Meissner

Sophie Whalen is a young Irish immigrant who agrees to marry a man she knows nothing about. San Francisco widower Martin Hocking proves to be as aloof as he is handsome. Sophie quickly develops deep affection for Martin's young daughter, but Martin's odd behavior leaves her with the uneasy feeling that something about her newfound situation isn't right. Then one evening a stranger at the door sets in motion a transforming chain of events. Sophie discovers hidden ties to two other women. The fates of these women intertwine on the eve of the April 18,1906 devastating

San Francisco earthquake, thrusting them onto a perilous journey that tests their resiliency and resolve and, ultimately, their belief that love can overcome fear. This story is a gripping novel about the bonds of friendship and mother love, and the power of solidarity. It is set within the massive earthquake that rocks San Francisco, igniting a devouring inferno. Lives are lost, lives are shattered, and some lives rise from the ashes forever changed.
