Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape provided.)
- Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
- Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
- Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.

Around the Town...



Town of Pawling, NY



Fifteen miles north of the Knolls is the Town of Pawling, a quintessential small town and village that offers a multitude of community activities and a variety of housing styles, including ranches, colonials, and clusters of Victorian homes. This 45-square mile town, with a population of over 8.200, is in the southeast corner of Dutchess County and part of the Hudson Valley region.

Pawling is a hub of shops, restaurants, and small businesses. Shopping includes the Anglers Den Flyshop, The Book Cove, Good Tidings Gift Shop, Pawling Antiques, and The Blue Olive gourmet grocery store. Community activities include the Pawling Concert Series which has brought hundreds of musicians to Pawling over the last four decades at the Gardiner Theater located in Trinity-Pawling School. The Music by the Lake series is presented by the town's recreation department and held at Lakeside Park. The park offers a scenic backdrop to hiking, biking, cross-country skiing, tennis courts, basketball courts, swimming, fishing, kayaking and more.

If you enjoy hiking, the Appalachian Trail is one of Dutchess County's largest parks with 30+ miles of trails within 4,000 acres and passes through the towns of Dover and Pawling (where there is free parking to access the trail). It has a new 1,600' long boardwalk spanning the Great Swamp, and also provides several sitting areas.



Dutcher Golf Course is a 9-hole golf course that is the oldest (c.1890) municipal public course in the US. Quaker Hill Country Club is a private, members only club that has one of the top 25 golf courses in the Hudson Valley, as well as tennis courts, croquet, a children's program, and dining. The Nine Old Men's Grill Room is one dining option and The Barn at Quaker Hill is a beautiful converted dairy barn that is used for large groups and special occasions.

Two popular restaurants in Pawling include O'Connor's Public House on 6 Broad Street and McKinney & Doyle Corner Bakery & Fine Foods Cafe on 10 Charles Colman Blvd. O'Connor's offers traditional irish pub food and live music. McKinney & Doyle offers American cuisine and made from scratch baked goods.

On September 10th, there will be a Sidewalk Sale from 10am-4pm and a Music by the Lake series event featuring "All in Band" from 7pm-10pm, both held at Lakeside Park. Who knows? You may bump into James Earl Jones who has a home in Pawling.



BOOK REVIEW – *The Guest List* by Lucy Foley

A wedding celebration turns dark and deadly in this thriller.

On an island off the coast of Ireland, guests gather to celebrate two people joining their lives together as one. The groom is a rising television star. The bride is an ambitious magazine publisher. It's a celebrity style wedding with a designer dress, a remote location, luxe party favors, and boutique whiskey. The cell phone service is spotty and the waves around the island are rough, but every detail has been expertly planned and set to be expertly executed. But perfection is for plans, and people are all too human. As the champagne is popped and the festivities begin, resentments and jealousies begin to mingle with the reminiscences and well wishes. The groomsmen begin the drinking game from their school days. The bridesmaid not-so-accidentally

ruins her dress. The bride's oldest friend gives an uncomfortably caring toast. And then someone turns up dead. Who didn't wish the happy couple well? And perhaps more important, why? A true mystery with likable characters who are friends uniting for a wedding. The author uses alternating points of view to keep you guessing. Also, pay close attention to seemingly small details about the characters' pasts. They are all clues.


