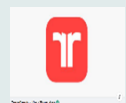

Once again, my garden is overflowing with vegetables, so I've been trying some new recipes. Here is one for a tasty Zucchini Pie:

**Ingredients:**

- 1 c. bisquick
- ½ c. vegetable or canola oil
- 4 eggs
- ½ tsp kosher salt
- ½ c. grated parmesan cheese
- ½ c. grated cheddar cheese
- 3 c. thinly sliced zucchini rounds (I cut them in half)
- 1 sm. sweet onion diced



Preheat oven to Bake 350° and spray 9" pie plate with cooking spray. Whisk bisquick, oil, eggs, salt. Add cheese and mix. Fold in zucchini & onion. Pour into pan and Bake 40-45 min. Garnish with parsley & preferred herbs.

### Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape provided.)
- Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
- Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
- Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.

### *The Spoon Stealer* by Lesley Crewe

Born into a basket of clean sheets—ruining a perfectly good load of laundry—Emmeline’s size and personality never quite fit in on her family’s rural Nova Scotian farm. She had beloved brothers who took care of her, but the family suffered multiple losses in the First World War and became so heavy with grief, toxicity, and mental illness that Emmeline felt their weight smothering her. She had gone to England to seek out a brother and stayed to rebuild her life. When she retired and was living in a small coastal town with her best friend, Vera, an excellent conversationalist who is also a dog, Emmeline decided to try to talk to more humans. When she joins a memoir-writing course at the library, her classmates don’t know what to make of her. Funny, loud, and with a riveting memoir, she charms the lot. As her past unfolds for her audience, friendships form with an unlikely group. She shares with them her third-biggest secret: She is a compulsive spoon stealer.

When Emmeline unexpectedly inherits the Nova Scotia farm she grew up on, she knows she needs to go see the farm and what remains of her family one last time. She arrives like a tornado in their lives, an off-kilter Mary Poppins bossing everyone around and getting quite a lot wrong. But with her generosity and hard-earned wisdom, she gets an awful lot right too. A pinball ricocheting between people, offending and inspiring in equal measure, Emmeline, in her final years, believes that a spoonful—perhaps several spoonfuls—of kindness can set to rights the family so broken by loss and secrecy. You cannot help falling in love with all the characters you meet along the way. I enjoyed this book immensely. It is full of humor, family secrets, friendship, lovable animals, and heart.

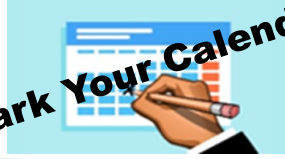

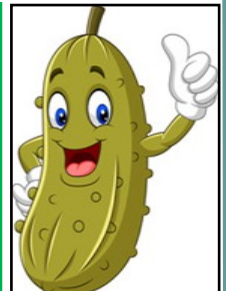

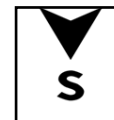
