Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape provided.)
- Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
- Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
- Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.



Chemist Elizabeth Zott would be the first to point out that there is no such thing as an *average* woman. It is the early 1960s and her all-male team at a research lab takes a very unscientific view of gender equality. One exception is a lonely, brilliant researcher who falls in love with Elizabeth's mind, resulting in true chemistry. But like science, life is unpredictable. Which is why a few years later Elizabeth finds herself not only a single mother, but the reluctant star of America's most beloved cooking show *Supper at Six*. Elizabeth has an unusual approach to

cooking using her science background and it proves hilarious and revolutionary. As her following grows, not everyone is happy. Elizabeth Zott isn't just teaching women to cook. She's daring them to change the status quo. Elizabeth refuses to accept limits placed on her by society and insists that others do the same. This laugh-out-loud funny, daring, and shrewd book was Amazon's best book of 2022 as well as the top book of the year by The Washington Post and New York Times! *Lessons in Chemistry* is as original and vibrant as its star.






