### **Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines**

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape provided.)
- Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
- Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
- Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.

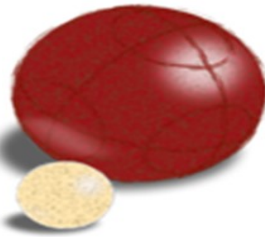




# BOCCE NIGHT

## **Out of my Mind** by Sharon M. Draper



The book *Out of my Mind* is by New York Times best selling author Sharon Draper. The events that occurred in this book were based on true events of the main character in the book, Melody Brooks. Melody's experiences are based on Sharon's daughter's disabilities. Melody is not like every other 11-year-old girl who can talk to her friends and run and play. Rather than that she sits in her wheelchair watching other girls in her grade have fun. When Melody was born, she was diagnosed with cerebral palsy. This is a group of disorders that affect a person's ability to move and maintain balance and posture. In the book Sharon Draper explains that Melody often feels like she is trapped in her body with no way out. But little do people know that she is extremely intelligent. She must suffer with the fact that people will never know about her intelligence. Yet her class, the so-called disabilities class, has learned the same thing for the past year, the alphabet. But people had no way to notice or see that Melody was a genius. At five years old Melody Brooks was called "Profoundly Retarded" by her doctor. She has always been looked down on not because people thought she wasn't smart. Just because she looked differently than everyone else and people judged a book by its cover. But when she starts 5th grade, she gets the chance to show everyone her true intelligence. This book really shows people that being different or having a disability doesn't mean that a person should be discriminated against or treated as a 'lesser' being; what really matters is what is on the inside. This is an outstanding book for all ages. This book is well written and will really change your mindset of people with all disabilities.

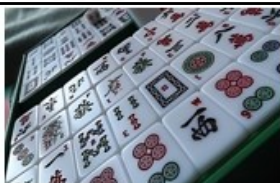
