 $\frac{1}{2}$  c. freshly grated Romano or Parmesan-Reggiano cheese (about 20z)

½ c. extra virgin olive oil

3 garlic cloves minced (about 3 teaspoons)

 $\frac{1}{4}$  teaspoon salt (more to taste)

1/8 teaspoon of freshly ground black pepper (more to taste)

Put all dry ingredients in a food processor and slowly add olive oil Store in plastic containers or mason jars

\*Or sub half for baby spinach leaves

#### Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape provided.)
- Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
- Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
- Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.





## Around the Town...



#### The Town of New Milford, CT

New Milford rests on the north-eastern shore of Candlewood Lake with a population of 28,000+ and is approximately 62 square miles. One of the five surrounding towns on Candlewood Lake, New Milford has a public beach, Lynn Deming Park, which is restricted to residents.

Candlewood Valley Country Club is a highly regarded public golf course in New Milford out in the rolling countryside beside the lake. The forgiving front nine will get out into your groove, followed by a back nine that will test your accuracy in a big way. The Clubhouse restaurant enjoys an elevated view of the 18<sup>th</sup> hole.



The Town Green is a gathering place for seasonal events with lawns and trees running down the east side of downtown New Milford and is occupied by Victorian homes, restaurants, civic buildings, and churches. Concerts are held in the summer, and you can check out the line up at https://artsnewmilfordct.org.

Lovers Leap State Park – was named after Princess Lillinonah (daughter of Pootatuck Indian Chief Waramaug) and her lover, both who jumped to their deaths from the rock at the turn of the

18th century. It is 365 metres high and has a great vantage point over the Housatonic River gorge. The 160-acre park is home to the stunning Lovers Leap Bridge. In the south-western nook of Lovers Leap is **Harrybrooke Park** which is on an estate with manicured gardens, two pavilions, picnic areas and a picturesque river walk.

If you enjoy the cultural scene, you can check out the **Village Center for the Arts**, a non-profit organization that offers a multitude of art classes and programs. **TheatreWorks** offers a variety of performances from March through December and their next show "Mornings at Seven" will be performed weekends beginning September 2<sup>nd</sup> through the 24<sup>th</sup>. New Hollywood release movies can be seen at the elegant **Bank Street Theater** which has been around since 1920.

The Elephant's Trunk Flea Market trades every Sunday from April to December, and no two weekends are alike. For more than forty years now, bargain-hunters and collectors have descended upon New Milford for this enormous outdoor market. Vendors come from all over the East Coast and on a typical Sunday there will be upwards of 500 all set and ready to trade by 7:00am.

**BANK STREET** – New Milford has a thriving main **shopping** street with local businesses including a yoga studio, toy shop, bookshop, jeweler, salon/spa, health food store, and a slew of **restaurants** on Bank Street and along Railroad and Main Streets. Some restaurants include:

Zaragoza is known for its tapas and craft cocktails.

Lucia Ristorante serves modern Italian cuisine and LaPiccolina offers Northern Italian Cuisine.

The Iron Rail is a casual steakhouse with a 40' bar.

Quick bites and healthy options are offered at the River & Rail Café.

The Cookhouse is one of the best barbecues in CT.

There is always plenty to see and do in New Milford.

Also, directly south of New Milford is the little town of **Bridgewater** which is holding their annual **Country** Fair **August 19 – 21.** Raising money for the volunteer fire department, it is a three-day celebration that offers food, amusement rides, vintage machinery, tractor pulls, live music, and a variety of competitions from eggs to pie-eating!



#### BOOK REVIEW - The Golden Cage by Camilla Lackberg

Faye has loved Jack since they were students at business school. Jack, a golden boy who grew up wealthy has worked hard to bury a dark past. When Jack needed help launching a new company, Faye left school to support him. When the business took off, Faye stayed home and cared for their daughter. She becomes wealthier than she ever imagined, but more and more removed from the excitement of the business world. When Faye discovers that Jack is having an affair, the polished façade of their life cracks wide open. Faye is alone,

emotionally shattered, and financially devastated—but hell hath no fury like a woman with a violent past bent on vengeance. Jack is about to get exactly what he deserves—and so much more. The Golden Cage is an over-the-top psychological thriller that tells the story of the scorned wife of a billionaire and her delicious plot to get revenge and bring him to his knees. This book has more twists and turns than I have read in a long time. There were serval times I thought I knew what was going to happen and a big surprise would come adding even more to the plot.






