Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape provided.)
- Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
- Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
- Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.



The NF Senior Center will hold their Annual Town Wide Tag-Bake-Plant Sale on Saturday, June 10th from 9:00am - 3:00pm.



WEST WITH GIRAFFES: A NOVEL by Lynda Rutledge



Based on a true story, this is an adventure, historical saga, and love story. The book explores what it means to be changed by the grace of animals, the kindness of strangers and the passing of time. In 1938 the Great Depression lingers, Hitler is threatening Europe, and world-weary Americans long for wonder. They find it in two giraffes who miraculously survive a hurricane while crossing the Atlantic. What follows is a twelve-day road trip in a custom truck to deliver Southern California's first giraffes to the San Diego Zoo. The story tells how a young Dust Bowl rowdy ended up behind the wheel and weaves real-life figures with fictional ones, including the world's first

female zoo director, a crusty old man with a past, a young female photographer with a secret. I agree with many of the reviews that this novel was a perfect balance between history and fiction, as well as a "fun and delightful" read. Happy Reading — Maureen Clegg








